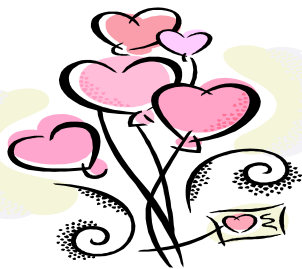


This year's annual meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 19th, 2008 at 7:30 PM at the Howard Johnson. All Association members are invited to attend.

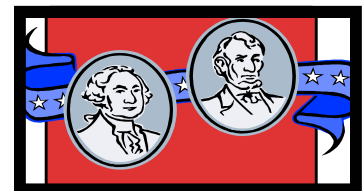
The financial statement will be available to members at the annual meeting or upon request.



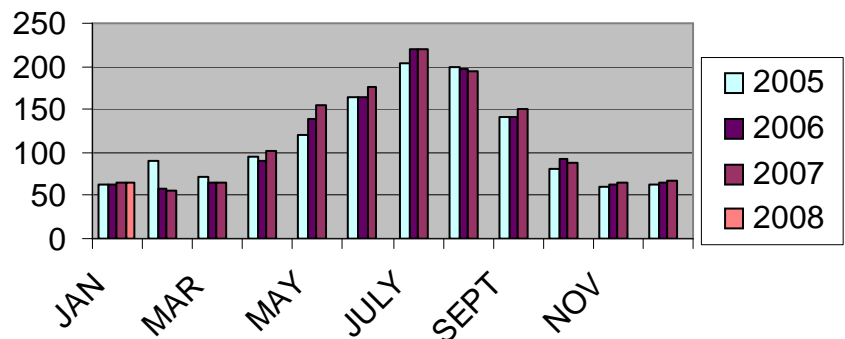
