NEW Automated Payment System



Nob Hill Water will **now** be offering an automated payment system that will allow customers to make a payment 24 hours a day. Payments can be made with debit or credit cards and checking or savings accounts. Payments will be reflected onto your Nob Hill Water account within 24 hours of payment.

All you will need is your Nob Hill Water account number and your form of payment.

There will now be a flat \$2.95 fee to use a card or bank account on any payment up to \$300.00. For those needing to make payments over \$300, multiple payments will need to be made in order to pay the full bill amount.

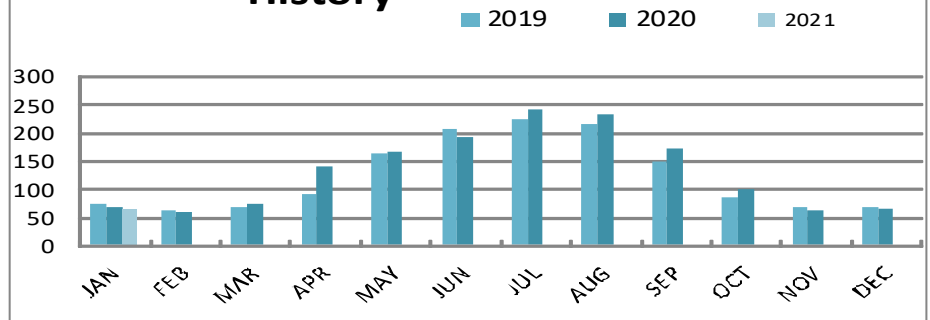

Nob Hill Water Annual Usage History





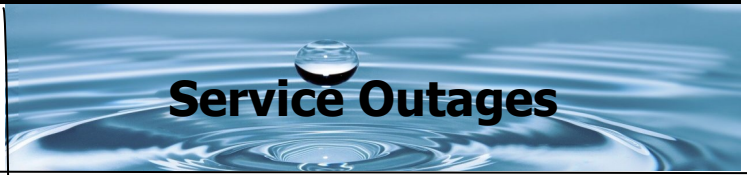
Well Project



It has always been the goal of Nob Hill Water Association to continue to improve our water system by adding capacity and reliability. In 2019, we completed a reservoir replacement project, which not only replaced a 70 year old concrete tank but also added additional storage to our system. This year we have taken on a new project and are drilling a new well. This new well will add source capacity to our system. Currently our system is supplied by five deep wells. These wells have more than enough capacity to supply our highest demand days when everything is working properly. The new well that is under construction will give us the ability to continue to provide service on these high demand days, even in the event that something goes wrong with one of our other wells. Well construction is slow but steady and we anticipate to be flow testing this fall and equipping the well with a pump and well house next spring/summer.
